Day 1: October 30, 2025-Departure For Thailand

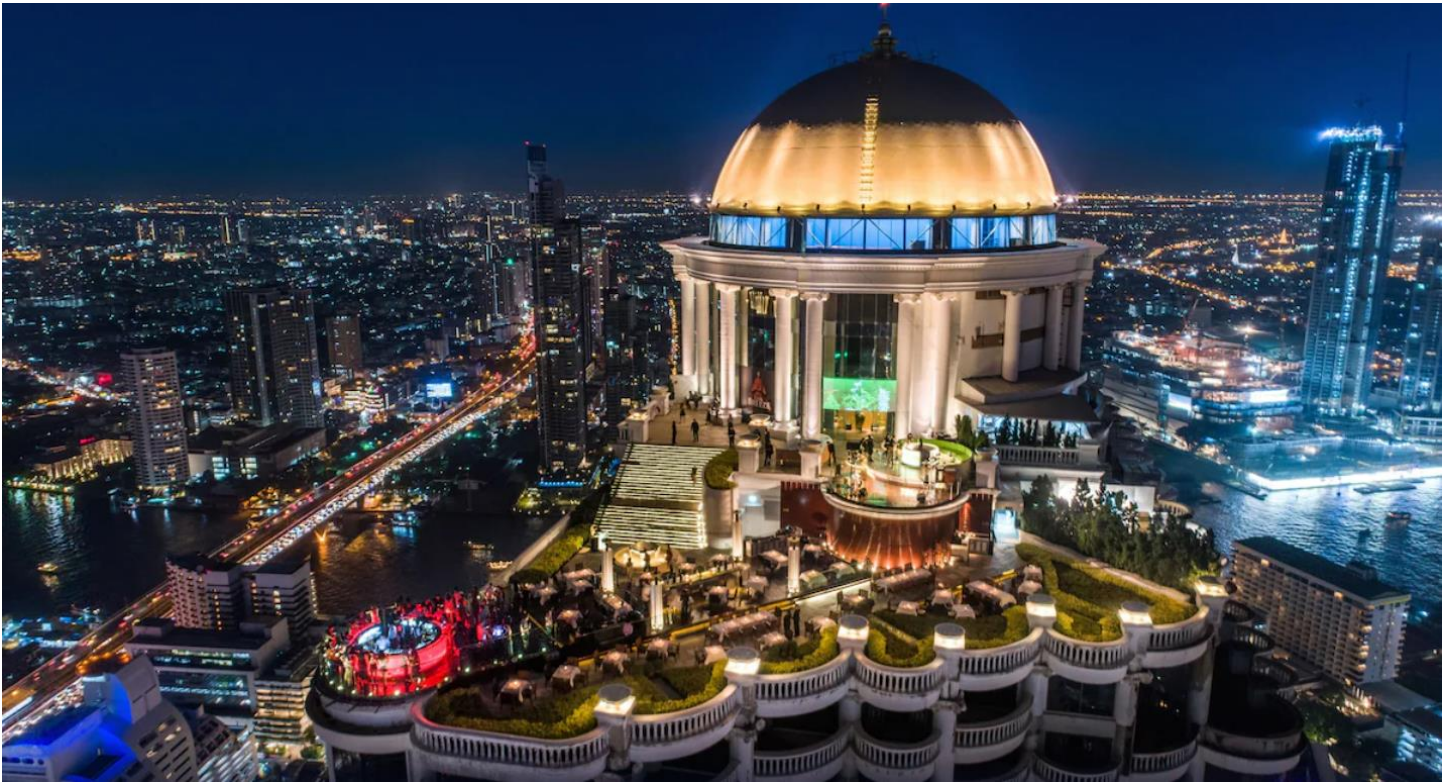
Depart for Bangkok Thailand from International Airport.

Day 2 : October 31, 2025

Arrive Bangkok Suvarnabhumi Airport, meet & greet by local English-speaking guide and transfer to your hotel in Bangkok
Rest of the day at leisure.

Day 3: November 1, 2025

Breakfast at the hotel

Full Day Bangkok Explorer

This is combination between the visiting to unique temples, and explorer the hidden small community in old town of Bangkok. This day excursion included the iconic riding in a Tuk Tuk, visit Wat Pho, the another side is Thai Traditional Massage School. The last visit is the Royal Palace and Wat Phra Kaew.

Start the day with **Wat Saket** which is easily recognized by its golden Chedi atop a fortress-like hill. The Golden Mount houses relics of Lord Buddha and affords visitors who climb its 318 steps a panoramic view of old Rattanakosin and the roofs of Bangkok. Next, we continue to the Monk's Alms Bowl Making Village "**Baan Batr**" which is the last existing place in Bangkok that still hammers out - by hand - the brass bowl that Buddhist monks carry with them during the morning alms round. Continue to **Wat Pho** - home to more Buddha images than any other Bangkok temples and sheltering one of the largest Buddha images in Thailand. From the nearby pier, we take the public ferry and cross the mighty Chao Phraya River to Bangkok's best-known landmark, the enchanting **Wat Arun** (Temple of Dawn).

Next, enjoy **lunch in a local restaurant** then an afternoon visit to the serene temple complex of **Wat Phra Kaew** (Temple of the Emerald Buddha) and **the Royal Palace**. The Emerald Buddha is the National sanctuary of the country, where the devotion is closely associated with the welfare of the Royal family and nation. The jade statue has a set of three robes and three crowns worn according to the seasons. Finish your day and transfer back to the hotel. (Remark: Dress code applies).

Day 4 : November 2, 2025

Full Day: Colourful Markets Around Bangkok

Bargaining is a way of life in Thailand and every trip should involve a look at some of the country's fantastic markets. We'll be watching as the catch is unloaded at Mahachai seafood pier, and we'll see the bustling activity as shrimps, cattle fish and a variety of bigger fish are auctioned off to vendors and frozen food processors. We'll also be watching as traders frantically pull the awnings of their stalls from the path of an approaching train at amazing Mae Klong Railway Market. Then we're off to the Benjarong House and Museum to watch skilled artisans at work, painting delicate designs on china, before we spend some time cruising the scenic canals and river on our way to unique Wat Bang Kung, a temple where a tiny chapel is completely embraced by the roots of a huge banyan tree.

06:30 hours

Depart Bangkok in the morning to **Mahachai**, home to one of the **biggest seafood piers in the Gulf of Thailand**. Stroll along the river towards the pier at the junction where Klong Mahachai canal and the Ta Chine River converge to watch fishermen offload their catch: big and small shrimps, myriad fish, cuttlefish, shellfish and other fruits of the sea. Deckhands slide baskets of seafood down from the boat into the hands of traders who immediately auction off the catches and distribute them either to one of the many frozen seafood plants in the area or to vendors at the fresh market just behind the pier.

Continue by van to explore the most famous is the lively **Damnoen Saduak Floating Market**. You'll be captivated by the buzzing scene along the canals as you take in the lush landscape and smiling faces

Continue to **Mae Klong Railway Market**. Walk around the market, then ready yourself for the hectic activities of the vendors along the railway tracks, when they raise the awnings of their stalls to clear the passage for the train on its return journey to Mahachai

Thai set lunch is at Baan Amphawa Resort.

Depart on a boat trip through the scenic canals, passing coconut and fruit orchards and rural dwellings. Continue by boat along Mae Klong River to **Wat Bang Kung**, built during the Ayutthaya period (more than 200 years ago). This interesting temple is completely embraced by the roots of a huge Banyan Tree. Return transfer to Bangkok (60-90 minutes, depending on traffic).

Back to the hotel

Evening: Bangkok at Night by Tuk Tuk

Bangkok is famous for its incredible street food, buzzing nightlife and it's iconic three-wheeled Tuk Tuk. So we have combined all three on our special evening excursion, ideal for couples and families. We start in vibrant China Town to try some of the best street food in Bangkok, before taking a tour of some of the city's flower market and most iconic sights,

magnificently lit up at night. The evening will end with a drink at an opened-air rooftop bar to enjoy a drink before being dropped off at your hotel.

Your evening starts by being picked up from your hotel by Tuk Tuk and then we first head to **Bangkok's Chinatown**. We arrive just as the sun has set and you will experience the bright lights of Yaowarat Road and Odeon Circle, driving around it to take pictures, the huge unmistakable and striking ceremonial Chinese gate marks the entrance. Off the main road are a series of smaller roads, narrow alleys and backstreets. Each of these offer a great insight into how the Chinese community have preserved their cultural traditions, celebrations and identities for over two centuries. The area was once renowned for being home to a dense warren of opium dens, gambling joints, brothels and pawnshops. Today it is the great food, fabric and gold that lures people to this area. Tonight you will taste a variety of local dishes, from different street food vendors. Back in the **Tuk Tuk**, we drive through **Rattanakosin**, the original area of Bangkok, established as the capital over 200 years ago. Enroute you will see many magnificent temples and architectural buildings, including the Grand Palace, Wat Pho, Sanam Luang and Democracy Monument.

We then stop at the rooftop bar of Sala Rattanakosin to savour a drink. Finish of the day with a locally crafted beer or a signature cocktail from the chic opened- air riverside bar. Relax and unwind while enjoying stunning views of Wat Arun and Wat Pho before being dropped off back at your hotel.

Day 5 : November 3, 2025

09:25 hours Transfer from hotel to Bangkok Airport for flight to Chiang Mai

12:25 hours Depart Bangkok by **PG225**

13:45 hours Upon arrival in Chiang Mai, meet & greet by local English-speaking guide and transfer to hotel in Chiang Mai

Afternoon drive up the serpentine road to the magnificently situated **Wat Doi Suthep**, this most sacred of Chiang Mai's temples (3,280 ft.) house of wealth of Buddha images, murals and Buddhist art. Then, visit **Wat Pha Lat** is nestled in the forest. There are no crowds, no shops of food stalls, no unwanted distractions. This Buddhist temple is as peaceful as it can get, sitting next to a waterfall and hiding under the three's canopy. After visit, return to hotel for dinner on our own and overnight.

Day 6 : November 4, 2025

07:45 hours Depart hotel and drive to **Kanta Elephant Sanctuary** for half day Elephant Care Program.

08:30 hours Arrive at Kanta Elephant Sanctuary. Walk through and learn about the elephants, change into traditional clothing and prepare fruits for our elephants.

09:00 hours Meet the elephants. Feed, interact, and play with the elephants in a natural environment and get muddy as you learn about their behavior and history. Take photos with the elephants.

10:00 hours Walk with and observe elephants when they are in a river for bathe and you have chance to join them.

11:00 hours Get some tea, coffee and season fruit then say goodbye to the elephants. Leave Kanta Elephant Sanctuary to the local restaurant for lunch.

12:30 hours Lunch at the local restaurant.

After lunch, visit Long Necked Karen Hilltribe and return to hotel

Evening, enjoy a superb and authentic Northern Thai Khantoke Dinner, complete with traditional entertainment such as folk dances and hilltribes presentations at Old Chiang Mai Cultural Center.

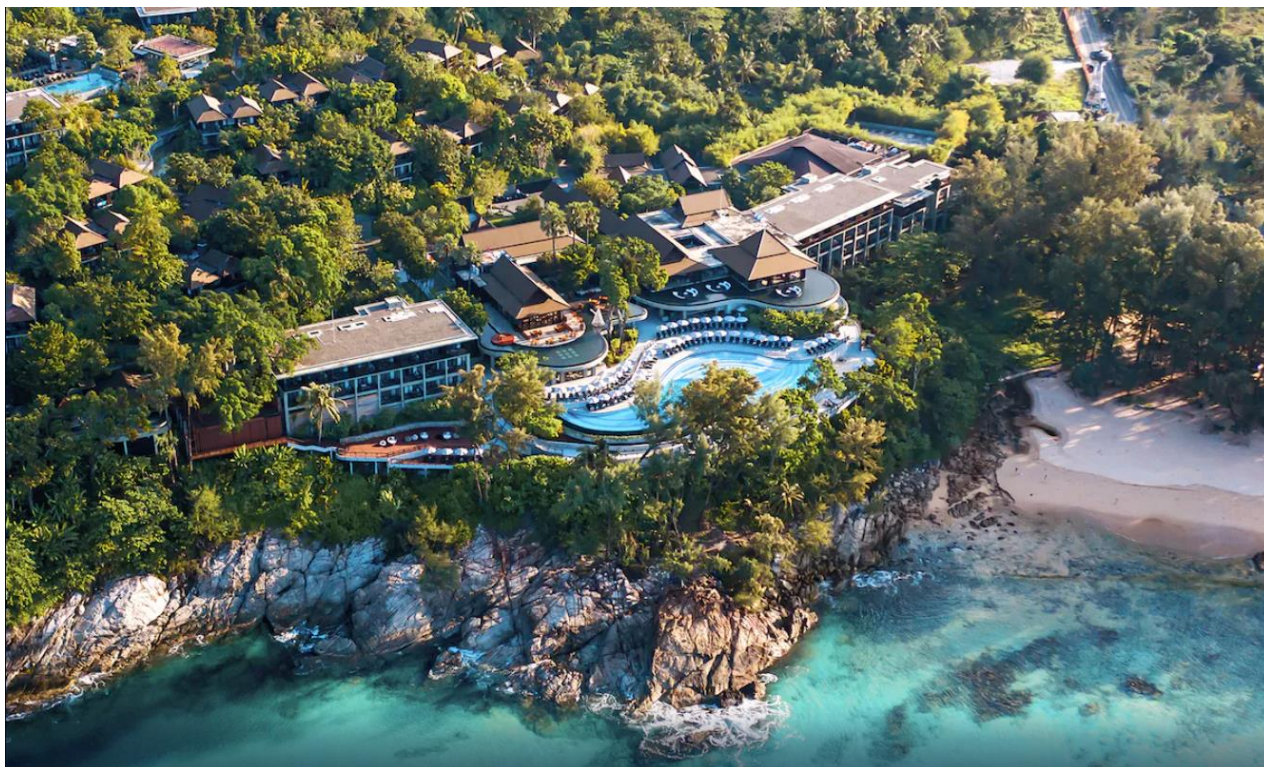
15:10 hours Arrive Phuket, meet & greet by local English-speaking guide and transfer to your hotel in Phuket

Full Day Phang Nga Bay by Speedboat & Canoe

Spectacular Phang Nga Bay has a unique landscape of twisted limestone outcrops, white, sandy beaches, secret lagoons and crystal clear waters. We'll be exploring beautiful Panak and Hong Islands where you can paddle an individual canoe, if you want to discover things for yourself. Our speed boat will take us to stunning Tapu Island, where the James Bond Movie "The Man with the Golden Gun" was filmed. We'll also drop in to see the natural wonders of Diamond Cave and Mangrove Cave at Panak Island. For lunch, we'll stop at remarkable Panyi Village, a fishing village built on pillars over the sea. We'll finish our wonderful day on Khai Nai Island snorkeling, swimming or simply relaxing on the beach.

Itinerary

07:30 hours	Pick up from your hotel and transfer to our departure lounge at Royal Phuket Marina.
09:00 hours	Depart from our pier to Phang Nga Bay
10:00 hours	Arrive at Panak Island for exploring: Cave & Lagoon. Depart to Hong Island for cave canoeing.
12:00 hours	Visit Tapu Island and Ping-Gun Island (Tapu island also called James Bond Island – where there were the filmed
13:30 hours	Arrive at Koh Panyi , a Muslim village built on pillars, it time for lunch in a village of historical traditionally built houses over the lovely blue-green waters on the shores of Koh Panyi
14:00 hours	Depart to Koh Kai Nai Island
15:15 hours	Arrive at Khai Nai Island , enjoy snorkelling and swimming.
16:30 hours	Arrive at Royal Phuket Marina and transfer to your hotel.
