

### **Bali Itinerary**

Bali - Ubud & Seminyak June 15 - June 24, 2025 10 days

\*The Scheduled Daily Itinerary is subject to change or slight modifications when necessary.

#### June 15, 2025: Departure

• Depart from International Airport to Ngurah Rai Airport in Denpasar, Bali.

## June 16, 2025: Arrive in Bali, you are met and greeted by your English speaking tour guide.

- Our Balinese girls wearing traditional dressed will welcome you with collar flower.
- After meeting services, you are transferred to your hotel in UBUD (drive 1 hour 45 minutes)
- Afternoon of Leisure

#### June 17, 2025: Full Day Tour

- After breakfast, you are escorted to visit UBUD Palace, Monkey Forest, Museum Lukisan Ubud
  - Ubud Palace, is an essential landmark in the Ubud area of Bali, Indonesia. The palace once housed the royal family and is known for its grandeur, Balinese architecture, stunning gardens, and surroundings. Visitors explore the charming courtyard and the magnificent buildings.
  - Ubud Monkey Forest, which lies within the village of Padangtegal. The village's residents view
    the monkey forest as an important spiritual, economic, educational, and conservation centre.
    There are many points of interest for guests to explore. Other than around 700 monkeys,
    guests can also see 186 species of trees in 12.5 hectares of forest. We return to our hotel for
    dinner on own and overnight
  - Museum Puri Lukisan, one of oldest museums in Ubud Bali. This museum specializes in Balinese traditional and modern painting as well as carvings, especially wood carvings
- Lunch will be served at a Local Restaurant. (Continued on next page)
- After lunch, we continue to Tegalalang rice terraces and try Luwak Coffee and The SWING -- (swing away and soar high above the magnificent Instagrammable scenic beauty and enjoy an unforgettable swing experience unlike any other.)
- On the way back to Hotel, last stop is Elephant Cave or Goa Gajah which dates back to 9th century. The primary carving resembles the face of the elephant, that's why the sanctuary is also known as the Elephant Cave
- Back to Hotel. Balance day is free

#### June 18, 2025: Full Day Tour

- After breakfast, you will be transferred to Temple for blessing and do a Yoga for an hour.
- We then continue to do Ritual at The Holy Spring Temple at SEBATU.
- Next, we will visit Elephant park at MASON (Interact /feed elephants / take pictures with these gentle giants)
  - This multi-award-winning park is Bali's only dedicated elephant rescue facility and is home to Bali's largest herd of critically-endangered Sumatran elephants, 6 of which were naturally born here. The park provides guests with the rare opportunity to learn and interact with these gentle giants while giving the healthy herd a comfortable and safe environment to call home.
- Lunch will be served at the Park
- After lunch, proceed to visit Gunung Kawi Temple and Batuan Temple is one of the most notable landmarks in the area with intricate stone carvings. It is located in the northern part of the Batuan village, 200 metres off the main road. The temple also has an inscription that testifies to the date of founding of Batuan in 1022 AD.
- Back to Hotel

#### June 19, 2025: Full day Tour

- Breakfast box will served at Hotel's lobby
- In the early morning, we drive to East Bali and visit The Gate of Heaven at Lempuyang Temple.
  - Lempuyang Temple is famous as the Gate of Heaven. A place of Hindu ancient Temple complex in the east of Bali. There are at least 7 temples from the foot of the hill to the top of the hill. Lempuyang temple is derived from the word "Lempu," which means light and "Hyang," meaning a spiritual entity for supernatural power who rules over the universe which is God himself. So, the meaning of "lempuyang" is a "Holy light of God". With 1700 stairs up to the top of the hill, the stunning view of eastern Bali is the prize when we arrive at the summit of Lempuyang hill.
- Next we will continue to visit The Bathing place of the former Karangasem's King at Tirta Gangga where we will participate in "melukat," a purification ritual to cleanse the body both spiritually and physically– from negative elements by washing the body in holy water that flows from a beautiful fresh-water spring inside the temple. There are many fountains pouring from the spring into the pool and each one has a different purpose/meaning.
- Lunch will be served at Candi Dasa Beach Resort
- After lunch, drive to visit the Balinese aborigines at Tenganan.
- On the way back to hotel our last stop is Bat Cave at Kusamba

#### June 20, 2025: UBUD – Transfer to SEMINYAK

- Breakfast at Hotel
- In the morning free at leisure until check out time at noon, you are transferred to Seminyak Beach.
- Arrive at Seminyak and check in at your hotel.
- The remainder of the is free /day of leisure, spa time etc.

#### **June 21, 2025** - Full day tour

- Breakfast at Hotel
- Drive to West North Bali and stop at JATILUWIH RICE TERRACES (the World Heritages of UNESCO
- Then continue to visit the Rainforest Temple at Batukaru and Ulun Danu Temple at Beratan Lake
- Lunch will be served at Local Restaurant
- After lunch, drive to Sea temple at Tanah Lot and we will enjoy the Sunset there
- Back to Hotel

#### June 22, 2025: Full day Tour

- Breakfast at Hotel
- Morning of leisure time
- Late afternoon, we drive to Ungasan and stop at GWK (The biggest statue of Wisnu GOD ridding the Garuda Bird)
- Then we enjoy the Beach Time at Padang Padang.
- Next, experience a Kecak and fire dance which can be seen at the Beautiful Luhur Temple at ULUWATU.
  - A Kecak Dance performance, is a colossal and magnificent traditional dance that depicts the story of Ramayana.
- Enjoy a Farewell Grilled seafood dinner will be served at Jimbaran Fisherman Villages.
- We then head back to the Hotel.

#### June 23, 2025

- Breakfast at Hotel.
- Whole day of leisure/relaxation. (Optional Spa Day or beach activities.)
